This was the HANSIK DREAM TEAM from Korea. Professor Gweon Ohcheon, and his two students, Lee Somin & Lee Jungseo from the Hotel Culinary Art & Bakery Department of Gyeongnam Provincial Namhae College joined a Korean food festival titled "An Evening of Art and Korean Cuisine" to showcase Korean food to UN representatives in New York. The current Korean ambassador is O Jun.

A great number of ambassadors and officials currently working for the United Nations were invited to enjoy Korean food. In fact, more than 50 individuals were invited to the festival. Ban Gimoon, current secretary-general of the United Nations was unable to join the festival due to an overseas trip. However, Yoo Soontaek, spouse of Ban Gimoon, joined the festival on his behalf.

Various kinds of food were well prepared by the Korean dream team, the HANSIK DREAM TEAM, for many customers who fully enjoyed the Korean food on offer. They said they were very impressed by its taste. Around 7 kinds of Korean food were introduced. Firstly, stuffed abalone with seaweed fulvescens sauce and chicken broth-based mung bean porridge with chicken balls were served as an appetizer. Then, halibut pancake with vegetables in beef broth and royal braised short ribs in soy sauce were also introduced. Finally, Bibimbab and Kimchi were introduced as the main dish. Lastly, preserved persimmon, pear in cinnamon ginger infused juice, assorted Korean traditional sweets and cookies, and

magnolia blossom tea were provided as dessert.

A new dish, titled 'halibut pancake with vegetables in beef broth' was created by professor Gweon Ohcheon. He said "this is a great opportunity to introduce many kinds of Korean food to UN ambassadors, and this is another kind of diplomacy. I am proud to join this kind of festival, and our food advertisement will be continued into the future in order to make Korean food, HANSIK popular".

This Korean community college HANSIK DREAM TEAM was awarded by the Food Festival administration on July 9th. Its official food festival title is "dream food festival among the Korean community colleges". Around six professors and twelve students participated from six Korean colleges: Namhae College, Daelim College, Mokpo Science University, Busan Women's College, Suwon Science College, and Woosong College.

The third Asian Culture Festival

The third Asian Culture Festival was hosted by Gyeongnam Provincial Namhae College, International Language Institute at the College restaurant on November 25th in 2015. The festival is for our Chinese students and local multi cultural residents.

The Korea-China Culture festival was choreographed by Namhae College for 9 exchange students from Shanghai Business College and Tsingtao Binhai College, 60 multi cultural family members from China, Vietnam and Cambodia and 100 Namhae College students.

The festival started with singing by two students from the Hotel Culinary Art & Bakery Department. Many events followed, such as the Korean-Chinese-Japanese fashion show, a Korean language contest, Chinese dictation, a well-being food contest, and a traditional tea contest as well as other similar events. Some Chinese food was prepared by students from our Hotel Culinary Art & Bakery Department. The festival was very well received by the audience.

This festival offered a great number of students and local residents a meaningful opportunity to grow in mutual understanding and reduce the sense difference between cultures. Multi-cultural family members were able to forget their nostalgia for a moment and have a great time.

Namhae College offered the exchange students many opportunities to learn about Korean culture: Korean lectures, temple stay, visits to Busan's historical sites, etc. This cultural exchange between Korea and China was regarded as the most important function of the festival. This is the reason the event was organised by Namhae County administration.

Namhae College has managed exchange student program with partners since 2007: Shanghai Business College in China, Agriculture College in Chungdo, and Saint Michael University in The Philippines. 59 exchange students have studied at Namhae College to date.

NCS fair

The NCS fair was hosted by Gyeongnam Provincial Namhae College campus (President Um Changhyeon) from November 26th to November 27th. The fair was hosted in order to promote the NCS (National Competency Standard)-based curriculum that has been promoted for the past two years and to share its exemplary results.

Many events were carried out during the fair: NCS workshops, a national bartender-cocktail making contest, demonstrations of job performance, job interviews and recruiting, a self-directed learning competition, a capstone competition and start-up item creation competition, amongst other events.

Seven university presidents and 21 NCS college officials from Incheon Jaeneung College, Yeungjin College, Yonam Institute of Digital Technology, as well as 200 local middle and high school students, joined the fair. Namhae College showed many NCS-based curricula for promotion: Culinary, Ship Building

& ITS Design, GIS, Total Station, Automated Robot Development Process, Factory Automation Process with HMI, Automatic Control System with PLC, Smart App Development, Bank Teller & Secretary, Landscape Sketch and Design, CO₂ and Welding Demonstration, 14 Official Job Demonstrations, Casino, Barista, Baking, Ship Body Assembly, Robot Development, etc. All visitors had the opportunity to join the work experience program.

In particular, the NCS displayed a variety of artifacts and department curricula to get the public's attention from 12 booths. Professor Kim Seokyoung, head of the NCS center said, "it has taken two years for our college to adopt the NCS-based curriculum as a marine industry specialization college. This fair will be a great opportunity to promote our college's status and share best practice in field-oriented education with other universities as a leading college in the NCS field".

The NCS Support center was established, and the NCS-based curriculum was reformed by Namhae College to provide efficient training.

NCS instructors were developed and trained, and an NCS-based curriculum & teaching methods were developed to complete the network. These measures have been fully supported by Namhae College.
